Welcome, we appreciate that you have decided to apply for membership in the Frederick County Republican Committee.

To ensure a harmonious and lasting working relationship, we would like to inform you of certain key qualifications necessary for your acceptance and continued relationship with our committee. Please read and understand the following **Important Membership Information**

1. According to the Party Plan of Virginia,
 - “A voter who, subsequent to making a statement of intent, publicly supports a candidate in opposition to a Republican nominee shall not be qualified for participation in party actions as defined in Article I for a period of four (4) years.”
 - “A member of an Official Committee is held to a higher standard of support for nominees of the Republican Party than an individual who merely participates in a mass meeting, party canvass, convention or primary. Therefore, a member of an Official Committee is deemed to have resigned his Committee position if he:
 - (a) Makes a reportable contribution to and/or
 - (b) Knowingly allows his name to be publicly used by and/or
 - (c) Makes a written or other public statement supporting the election of a candidate in opposition
 - to a Republican nominee in a Virginia General or Special Election, and/or
 - (d) Becomes an officer of any other political party.
2. Your application must be submitted, with the current dues amount attached to the Membership Application
3. You must attend one meeting as a guest before the application process is started (it may be the same meeting you submit your application).
4. Your application will be processed and brought before the committee for a vote, generally at the next meeting.
5. Once your application has been voted in, your check will be processed to establish your voting rights.
6. Please note that our bylaws and the RPV Party Plan state specifically that a member who misses three consecutive meetings is deemed to have resigned their membership in the committee. There is no re-instatement process. You must reapply with the same conditions as a new member, no exceptions.
7. Proxy attendance and/or proxy voting is allowed. An individual may not cast more than one vote, so a Committee member may not carry a **proxy**, only non-members may do so. The **proxy** holder must be a member of the **Republican Party** and reside in the same Magisterial District as the absent member whose **proxy** he or she carries.
